

- Never operate the system if it's in moist environment or its electrical components has contact with liquids. ·Don't clean the product while the power is still connected.
- Don't disassemble or replace components while the power is still connected.
- Unplug the appliance when the system isn't in use, and place the power plug out of children reach.




Before Installing


It's important to check the performance and functionality of your lift before commencing with the installation into a cabinet. When testing the lift outside the cabinet ensure it is suitably supported and be careful not to place your hands near/on any moving components.


- 1. Plug the control box to the lift body, and connect the power supply to the control box as shown in installation step 1.
- 2. Plug the power lead into the power supply then into the your mains wall socket.


You may need to pair your remote control for first time use, refer to the "Pairing the Remote Control" section for instructions on completing this.


Ensure the lift operates as expected along the full stroke height. The motion should be smooth and near silent.





















Pairing the Remote Control



STEP1: With the TV lift powered on, press the small button on the control box with a thin tool as shown. The unit will emit a beep, indicating that the control box is ready for pairing.

STEP2: Press the "ⓐ" button on the remote control. You should hear repeated beeps for approximate 10 seconds indicating that the remote control is being paired. A final beep will indicates success.

Note: To clear any previously paired remote controls press and hold the small button on the control box. You will hear a beep followed by a 2nd beep after 5 seconds. You may now release the button and pair a new remote control.

Operating Instructions

1. Raise/Lower the TV

Press and hold the " \triangle " button to raise and the " \bigvee " button to lower the TV.

2. Memory Settings


Press and hold the "mem1" or "mem2" button for 3 seconds until you hear a beep. This saves the current position into the "1" and "2" buttons.

3. Recall Memory

Press the "1 " or "2" button and the TV lift will automatically move to the position saved by the corresponding "(mom1)" or "[mom2)" button.

4. Lowest Height Limit

Short press the "mont" button five times, after each press you will hear a beep and at the 5th press two beeps. This indicates the current height is now saved as the lowest height setting.



5. Default Setting

To automatically position the TV lift at the lowest settings press the "OK" button. Pressing a 2nd time will stop the TV lift.

6. Reset

Press and hold the "OK" button for 3 seconds until you hear a beep. The TV lift will lower all the way down and then raise a short amount. This will reset the lowest height limit.

7. Mobile app connection

Press the "mem" button 5 times, after each press you will hear a beep and at the 5th press two beeps. This indicates the TV lift is disconnecting from the Wi-Fi. A further one beep indicates the TV lift has been disconnected and is ready to be discovered by the Tuya app again.

Mobile App Setup

The TV lift is controllable through a mobile app named Tuya Smart. Once setup, you and other household members can operate the lift through the mobile app. It's also possible to configure the Tuya app to integrate with voice assistants like Amazon Alexa and Google Assistant.

- This guide is for illustration purposes only, the screenshots, steps and procedures may be different in the latest version of the app.
- The app requires the setup of a free account with Tuya but you can test the functionality as a guest.
- The TV lift is capable of connecting to 2.4GHz Wi-Fi networks.
- Sharing the TV lift with other household members and use of voice assistants requires internet access.

The app is available on the Google Play store and Apple's App store, scan the correct QR code below to get started.












Troubleshooting

This troubleshooting guide will assist you in identifying and solving common problems and answering questions you may have about the product. Contact your distributor should the answer to your question or problem not be found in this troubleshooting guide and/or for any after service parts and sales support.

1. Possible reasons the TV Lift doesn't respond to the remote control.

a. TV Lift

- If the TV lift beeps 3 times after pressing any button, the TV lift is in an error state and requires a reset. Please follow step 6 of the operating instructions.
- If the TV lift beeps 4 times after pressing any button the lift may have shut down to prevent overheating. This can happen when the lift has been operated a lot within a short period of time. The control box should resume normal operation after a short while.
- Check the all the connections and switches between the wall socket and the TV lift.
- If the TV lift beeps once after pressing a button this indicates incorrect operation. Please refer to the Operating Instructions for proper use of the TV lift.

b. Remote Control

- The distance between the remote control and the TV lift may be too large. An acceptable range should be less than 10m (30 ft).
- The batteries in the remote control may be low. Replace the batteries.
- The remote control may be broken. Check to see if the indicator LED found at the top left of the remote lights when a button is pressed. If not, contact your distributor for a replacement.

2. TV Lift stops moving during operation and emits a long beep.

- Check to see if an obstacle is present that impedes the free movement of the lift. Remove if present and retry.
- The weight of the TV may exceed the maximum weight limitation.
- The motor wire may be broken, reset the TV lift. If the problem still exists contact your distributor for a replacement.

3. TV Lift is making an abnormal noise or sound

– Check all connections and reset the TV lift. If noise continues contact your distributor for advice or purchase a replacement.
